Investment strategy

The MySuper investment option gains its exposure to a diversified portfolio of investments through a mix of investment managers.

The MySuper investment option provides a mix of growth and defensive assets which is weighted towards growth-focused assets (e.g. shares), with moderate exposure to defensive assets (e.g. cash).

A mix of passive, factor-based and active investment managers may be selected to manage the assets of the MySuper investment option, providing differing, yet complementary, investment styles to achieve more consistent investment returns.

The MySuper investment option is authorised to utilise approved derivative instruments for risk management purposes and investment efficiency, subject to the specific restriction that the derivative instruments are not used to gear portfolio exposure.

The underlying managers may utilise strategies for the management of currency exposure. It is the strategy of the MySuper investment option that international currency exposure may be hedged.

Quarter highlights as at 30/06/2024

- In the Australian shares portfolio, AllianceBernstein and IOOF QuantPlus were removed, and Alphinity (large cap growth), Martin Currie (dynamic value), OC Funds Management (mid caps) and Antares Equity (large cap core) were added during the quarter.
- The alternative defensive portfolio outperformed, with all Metrics portfolios and the Tanarra Asia Pacific portfolio all outperforming.
- Emerging Markets outperformed, with Intrinsic and Neuberger being the major contributors.
- The alternative growth portfolio outperformed its benchmark with strong performance from Intermediate Capital Group.
- Global shares underperformed, with Vaughan Nelson the major detractor.
